Healing California

OUR PROGRAM

Healing California never charges our patients or partners for care. We don't seek reimbursement from insurance or the government. We rely on individual and institutional donations to fund our work and volunteer professionals to provide care.

We partner with other non-profits and community groups to provide the free, quality dental, medical, and vision services their clients so desperately need.

Healing California brings treatment straight to patients at veteran stand downs, community health events and now with our mobile van – communities throughout the state. Our commitment to serving rural areas further lowers barriers to care.

We Love Our New Van!

The effects of the Coronavirus were far-reaching and catastrophic. Many of us felt unprepared and overwhelmed by the speed and enormity of the pandemic.

But when other organizations simply shut down for the year, our donors provided Healing California with a dental van that let us quickly resume safe, infection-controlled health care. It's been a huge success, reaching 400 dental patients in 21 clinic days in 16 weeks, and the van is booked solid through the first half of 2021!

Soon, the virus will subside and we'll return to our group clinic model. As we do, the van will shift to serving remote, rural areas - where free clinics usually never go - to give people the care they so desperately need, and too often go without.

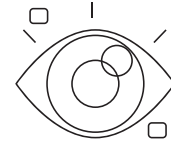

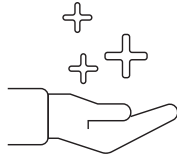

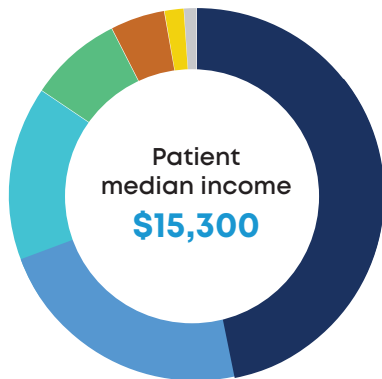

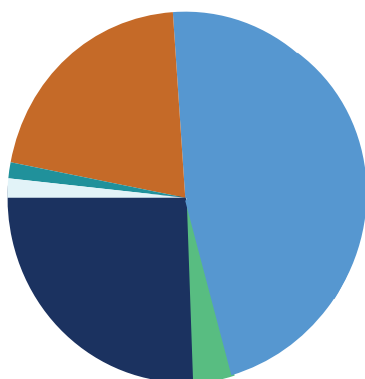

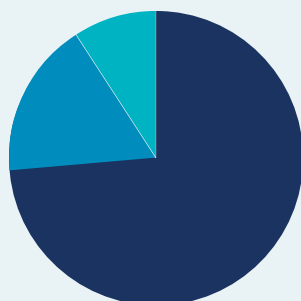
