



Whether due to economic barriers, transportation barriers, or gaps in insurance, many Californians lack access to critical healthcare services, including dental and vision care.

We work to solve these challenges directly, by bringing free treatment straight to the patients. Our mobile clinics are targeted toward underserved and disadvantaged Californians — primarily homeless veterans — who lack access to medical services due to financial and/or accessibility challenges.

We recruit local medical professionals and provide them with all the equipment, supplies, and support they need to relieve pain, clear infection, and restore functional vision to people. There's no red tape, no insurance forms or other paperwork to deal with. All our volunteers do is take care of patients.


